Job Summary

- (i) Pilot or navigate the boat safely and efficiently
- (ii) Pilot or navigate the boat when transferring passengers
- (iii) Maintain rescue equipment on the boat
- (iv) Carry out basic boat maintenance and cleanliness
- (v) Oversee boat house keeping
- (vi) Report any incidents and occurrences to the head of station;
- (vii) Disseminate relevant safety information, instructions and guidance to boat users onboard;
- (viii) Provide directions and instructions during emergencies.
- (ix) Report any mechanical problems of the boat;

Qualifications

- (i) Certificate of Proficiency as Coxswain in accordance with the Merchant Shipping (Training and Certification) Regulations as amended or equivalent from a recognized institution;

- (ii) A minimum of five (5) years relevant experience preferably in marine transport industry
